

Rose of Jericho (Selaginella lepidophylla)

GROWING INSTRUCTIONS

Also known as the Resurrection or Dinosaur Plant, this specimen is a type of spike moss found in the Chihuahuan desert of Mexico, New Mexico, and Arizona.

This unique plant doesn't need to be planted in soil. Instead, choose a shallow bowl or dish and fill with water, placing the base 1-2" of the plant in the water. Over a few hours, the plant will re-hydrate, unfurling its leaves.

They also prefer bright and indirect light.

This is a great selection for those with a "black thumb" as they're nearly indestructible. When deprived of water, they'll return to their dormant state and can remain that way for a *long* time. You'll want to give them a break from their pool once a month for approximately a week each time. That's all there is to it!

The Rose of Jericho is said to erase negative influences, bring peace, harmony, and abundance, and is a rare magical botanical, often sought after for use in Jewish, Voodoo + Santeria traditions.
