CALLISIA CARE GUIDE



Callisia Nickname: Turtle Vines

WATERING

Keep the soil consistently moist (but not soggy). Prolonged drought can lead to death because they have a low threshold for drying out.Water when the top 1" of soil is dry. Bottom watering is recommended so mold does not grow on the soil surface.

FERTILIZE

Fertilize every 4th watering with a general houseplant fertilizer. Back down to every 6th watering in the winter when growth is slower.

SOIL TYPE

An all-purpose potting soil will provide the growing conditions this plant needs to thrive.

LIGHT

Bright but indirect light. A West or East facing window is ideal where the plant can receive morning or evening sun. Direct midday sunlight on the leaves will cause sun scorch.

GROWTH

Growing as a low growing ground cover, these plants are great for terrariums.

AIR

Average humidity will be fine for this houseplant.
