Sansevieria

LET'S GET TO KNOW YOU

Hardy and beautiful, Sansevierias (AKA snake plants) are a popular choice for first time plant-parents.

LIGHT

Adaptable. Your Sansevieria will appreciate medium to bright indirect light, but also be very tolerant of low light conditions. They even enjoy direct sunlight from time to time!

WATER

When in doubt, let it drought! Following succulent rules, only water your Sansevieria when the soil has completely dried out, and make sure to discard any excess or standing water after watering. The most common mistake with Sansevieria is overwatering. Soil probes are also great tools for determining your soil moisture level.

FERTILIZER

Feed your Sansevieria once every 6 months with a gentle water-soluble fertilizer.

PLACEMENT AND TEMPERATURE

Hardy and drought tolerant, Sansevierias enjoy drier atmospheres. This being said, it is still a good idea to keep your plants away from overly drafty areas and active A/C and heating vents. Otherwise, Sansevierias will do just fine in temperatures ranging from 55° to 85°F, although they generally prefer being on the warmer side.
